Early Childhood Yard Social Distance Markers	1 st grade 8:10am Kindergarten 8:20am PreKindergarten 8:30am	 Parents will line up by the middle entrance to Early Childhood Yard. There are markers on the ground to promote social distancing. Face mask/PPE MUST be worn at ALL times. All students must have a Health Screening Form (digital or paper form) to be permitted into the school building. All students will have their temperatures taken with a contactless thermometer. Once cleared families will be directed to a social distance marker and parents will escort children into the Early Childhood Yard. Everyone must maintain social distance. Parents will escort children to designated social distance markers in the Early Childhood Yard. Parents will not be allowed to enter the school building with their child as per the New NYCDOE policy. Please be on time so that social distancing may be effective. Teachers will pick up and transition students ONLY from Early Childhood Yard each morning

All students MUST have a Health Screening Form.

All students MUST wear a mask.

All students are subject to DAILY temperature screenings.

The NEW NYCDOE policy is that all visitors must have an appointment. This includes parents.

All visitors are subject to temperature screenings and must wear a mask.

Parents must show valid identification at the school safety desk.

Students who arrive late <u>must</u> enter through the <u>main entrance</u> will be screened, must wear a mask, and will then be escorted by a staff member to the main office.

Parents will not be permitted beyond the safety desk.

Caregivers may then pick up students from the classroom teacher following dismissal procedures. It is imperative that you pick up on time so that social distancing may be effective. Parents will only be allowed to enter the Early Childhood Yard once your child's class is present in the yard, not before to limit the amount of people in the yard.
	Pre-Kindergarten 1:30pm	 Please wait for the teacher to pass your child to you. Please stand on a social distance marker.

All grades will be dismissed at designated staggered times. Please adhere to your child's dismissal time.

Second, Third, Fourth & Fifth Grades

Early Childhood Yard Social Distance Markers Gymnasium	3 rd , 4 th & 5 th gr. 8:00am 2 nd grade 8:05am	 Parents will line up with their child on the social distancing markers by the entrance to Early Childhood Yard. Face mask/PPE MUST be worn by everyone at ALL times. All students must have a Health Screening Form (digital or paper form) to be permitted into the school building. All students will have their temperatures taken with a contactless thermometer. Once cleared the student will proceed through the Early Childhood Yard following the social distance markers in into the Gymnasium. Parents will not be allowed to enter the Early Childhood Yard. Students will line up on social distancing markers in the gym and await their teacher. Teachers will pick up students and escort them to their classroom.

All students MUST wear a mask.

All students are subject to DAILY temperature screenings.

The NEW NYCDOE policy is that all visitors must have an appointment. This includes parents.

All visitors are subject to temperature screenings and <u>must wear a mask.</u>

Early Childhood Yard Social Distance Markers	3rd - 5th Grades 1:20pm 2 nd grade 1:25pm	 Teachers will escort children to designated social distance markers in the Early Childhood Yard. Teachers will dismiss 4th & 5th grade students who have written permission to walk home on their own first. Only one parent will be allowed to enter the Early Childhood Yard once your child's class is present in the yard, not before to limit the amount of people in the yard. It is imperative that you pick up on time so that social distancing may be effective. Please wait for the teacher to pass your child to you. Please stand on a social distance marker.

All grades will be dismissed at designated staggered times. Please adhere to your child's dismissal time.

LATE PICK UP

If a parent or guardian arrives late, they must wait outside the gate until the last group has been dismissed from the Early Childhood Yard.

Please be on time to pick up your child as this wait could be up to 20 minutes.

Only then may they line up in the Early Childhood Yard

Parents are to stand on a Social Distance marker or 6ft apart

The students will be inside the late pick up holding area located in the 1st floor Gymnasium.

A staff member will bring the student out to the parent in the Early Childhood Yard.

Parents will not be allowed to enter the building.

Back To School TIPS:

Please set expectations for your child to maintain the masks on throughout the day. Send an extra mask in your child's book bag. Label their masks with their name. Speak to your child about social distancing expectations each day.

Screen your child at home prior to coming to school if he/she is attending in person.

If he/she is sick please do not send them to school.

Keep track of your cohort on a calendar- post it on your refrigerator and schedule it on the calendar on your phone as a reminder.

Provide updated parent contact information to <u>parentcoordinator@robertesimon.org</u> as well as your child's teacher if you have changed your contact information.

Please ensure to set up arrangements for an alternate pick up person in case of an emergency and your child needs to be picked up early.

Teachers will have office hours daily please contact your teacher about any inquiries through the established communication they will share with you.

If you send your child to school with lunch, please ensure that it is peanut/nut free.

Breakfast and Lunch are available every day in the classroom for all students.
